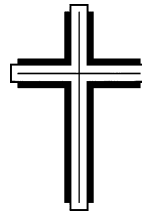

80th Anniversary of the Diocese of Youngstown: A special Mass commemorating the 80th Anniversary of the Diocese will be celebrated Sunday, **June 25, 2023**, at 4:00 p.m. in Saint Columba Cathedral. The Diocesan Archives is setting up a historical display which will be available before and after Mass.
